FACILITY OVERVIEW

Hamilton County Public Health records for this landfill are limited. Therefore, the exact location of disposal is unknown. The only document relating to the site is a 1994 "Draft Phase I Environmental Site Assessment" completed by the Army Corp of Engineers on the property immediately west of this site. The assessment indicates *"the site was used to dump building materials, brush, refrigerators, etc."* Additionally, the report indicates the village *"is continuing to dump building materials, plastic, brush, and other miscellaneous debris"*.
