FACILITY OVERVIEW

Hamilton County Public Health records for this landfill are limited. Therefore, it is unknown if waste was disposed of on the property or the exact location of disposal. Based on review of aerial photographs, in 1970 (Figure 3-3.1-A) the northwest portion of the property was cleared and had two small structures located in this area. By 1973 the structures are no longer present. An aerial from 1976 (Figure 3.3.1-B) shows a commercial building has been constructed in the far northwest corner of the parcel. Some land disturbance is evident on this aerial

and other aerials from the 1970's. Based on records, during 1975 and 1976 Vincent Caravella inquired with the Ohio EPA about using the property as a sanitary landfill. The property was ultimately determined to be unsuitable for use as a sanitary landfill. At the time of the correspondence the property was described as a "solid fill type disposal site". During the 1970's this type of disposal may have included C&DD. The commercial building was removed sometime in the early 1980's and the property appears to be unused since then.

SITE INSPECTIONS

The site was inspected by HCPH on February 24, 2023. No violations or nuisance conditions related to the former landfill were observed on the site. There are various areas with some partially exposed tires, metal, foam cushions, etc. These may be remnants from filling or could be deposited during flood events since this area is in the flood plain of the adjacent Little Miami River.

SITE PRESENT DAY

At present today the property is undeveloped woodland with no direct access.
